The class will be held for three evenings virtually, with an experienced ASHI Certified Inspector and tenured ASHI School Instructor.


You will have the opportunity to participate in reviewing exam questions and in discussions. On the third day, you will take a 200-question practice exam and review the most common incorrect questions based on class results.
